COVID-19 Crisis in India – Appeal for Donations

Namaste,

India faces an **unprecedented crisis** due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Daily, India reports unwanted world record number of deaths and infections. This is exacerbated with an acute shortage of adequate intensive care beds, medicines and especially oxygen supplies. Quite simply, India's battered health system cannot cope.

Our **Navsari District Region** has similarly been gravely impacted. To provide some relief, and provide additional hospital beds and medical oxygen for COVID-19 patients in the region, The Association of Mandhata Samaj UK (AMSUK) has identified "**COVID HELP CENTRE**", located on the Ground floor, Prabhakunj Heights, Opp. ICICI Bank, Sandkuwa, Navsari.

The founder of Prabhakunj Foundation, Mr. Jiral Patel and Dr. Dikesh Patel of Life Care Hospital have jointly set up 30 beds (with additional 20 beds in the very near future) General Facility, Covid Help Centre. The staff includes; the Management Committee led by Jiral Patel, 4 Doctors, 15 Nurses and 8 Helpers. Further details of the facility and conditions for admission can be found on the Poster below in Gujarati and English.

The immediate priority is the provision of Oxygen supplies. The CA Association of Navsari have donated £20,000 for an Oxygen production plant equipment. Immediate funds are required towards the £12,000 costs for the installation and commissioning of the plant.

Therefore, to assist AMSUK have launched a "**COVID AID APPEAL**" to raise a **minimum of £15,000** to support the COVID HELP CENTRE for the benefit of the less fortunate and hopefully **save lives**.

કોવિડ હેલ્પ સેન્ટરમાં નીચે મુજબના અગત્યના મુદ્દા સમગ્રને સહકાર આપવાનો રહેશે.

- ૧)આ કોવિડ હેલ્પ સેન્ટરમાં ICU અને વેન્ટિલેટરની સુવિધા ન હોવાથી ૯૦%થી નીચે ઓક્સિજન લેવલ હોય એમને દાખલ કરવામાં આવશે નહીં.
- ૨)આ કોવિડ હેલ્પ સેન્ટરમાં માત્ર દરેક દર્દીને બપોરે જમવાનું,સવાર-સાંજ ચા નાસ્તો,ફૂટસ, પાણી ફીમાં આપવામાં આવશે.
- ૩)આ કોવિડ હેલ્પ સેન્ટરમાં માત્ર ૧૦૦/- રૂપિયાનો ચાર્જ રાખવામા આવેલ છે.
- ૪)આ કોવિડ હેલ્પ સેન્ટરમાં ડોક્ટરની સલાહ મુજબ દવા દર્દીએ પોતે સ્વ-ખર્ચે લાવવાની રહેશે.
- ૫)આ કોવિડ હેલ્પ સેન્ટરમાં દર્દીને ઓક્સિજનની જરૂર પડે તો સિલિન્ડર રીફિલિંગનો માત્ર ચાર્જ આપવાનો રહેશે,ટ્રાન્સપોર્ટેશન ફીમાં રહેશે.
- ૬)જો દર્દી ઓક્સિજનની સુવિધામાં દાખલ થાય અને જો ઓક્સિજન લેવલ ૯૦% થી ઓછું થઈ જતું હોય તો તેમના વાલીઓએ જાતેજ તાત્કાલિક ICU અને વેન્ટિલેટરની સુવિધાવાળી હોસ્પિટલમાં ખસેડવાના રહેશે.
- ૭)કોવિડ દર્દીને જરૂરિયાત મુજબના ઇન્જેક્શનની સગવડ દર્દીના વાલી મિત્રએ સરકારી નિયમ મુજબ કરવાની રહેશે.

The founder of Prabhakunj Foundation, Mr. Jiral Patel and Dr. Dikesh Patel of Life Care Hospital have joined together to set up a 30 beds general facility, Covid Help Centre, based on the Ground floor, Prabhakunj Heights, Opp. ICICI Bank, Sandkuwa, Navsari.

Admission to the Covid Help Centre will be subject to the following conditions:

- 1) As the centre does not currently have any ICU or Ventilator facilities, any patient with oxygen level below 90% will not be admitted.
- 2) There will be Rs 100 charge per patient to be paid on admission.
- 3) All patients will be provided with free water, lunch, fruits, morning and evening tea with snack.
- 4) All patients will be required to purchase their own medicine as prescribed by their doctor.
- 5) An oxygen cylinder will be provided free of charge to the patient upon admission. However, subsequently if a refill is required, then this will be at a charge to the patient but the transportation of the oxygen cylinder will be free.
- 6) In the event that oxygen level of any patient falls below 90%, the relatives of patient will have to organise to shift the patient to a hospital which is equipped with ICU and Ventilator facilities.
- 7) As per the Government guidance all Covid patients admitted at the centre that may need injections, would have to be organised by the family and relatives of patients.
